MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Introduction

The International Committee for Fair Play (CIFP) defends and promotes Fair Play world-wide and has as target groups the national and international sport and education organizations as well the professional athletes, with a special emphasis on children, adolescents and those in charge of training them, namely coaches and trainers. The CIFP is recognized by the International Olympic Committee.

The CIFP plays an important educational role in supporting Fair Play, promoting a better understanding of Fair Play values and preventing adverse behavior. In cooperation with various national governing bodies, such as Ministries, Olympic Committees, Sports Federations, Media and Sports Press Associations, the CIFP encourages and welcomes the establishment of national Fair Play Committees.

The European Fair Play Movement (EFPM) is a non-governmental association joined by the national Fair Play Organizations of the majority of the European countries. Its main goal is the promotion of the ethical values of sports in its broadest sense, in all sport activities as well as in daily life, at European level. The EFPM is recognized by the European Olympic Committees (EOC).

The EFPM, considering that sport without values has no future, seeks to contribute to create a better world in the spirit of Fair Play values and principles and on the basis of the educational values laid down on the Olympic Charter.

Memorandum of Understanding Items

The CIFP and the EFPM, preserving their independent status and their own character, declare herewith a "Memorandum of Understanding" in matters of sports, tolerance and Fair Play.


This "MoU" includes the following items:

- The CIFP and the EFPM will try to establish and to coordinate common activities in matters of fair play, tolerance, peace and understanding.
- The CIFP and the EFPM will strive step by step to have a close co-operation, by supporting the aims and goals of both organizations, promoting both activities, such as Conferences and Workshops on the above mentioned topics.
- The CIFP and the EFPM will enable each other to publish articles and information in their respective official publications, web pages and magazines.
- The CIFP and the EFPM will nominate a member of its Executive Committees as regular contact persons. These representatives will meet preferably at the General Assemblies and/or Congresses of the two Organizations, with the possibility of short presentations of their annual activities.
- The CIFP and the EFPM representatives will discuss the activities of both Organizations during the above mentioned events and. If useful and necessary, they will duly coordinate them.

The above Memorandum of Understanding text will be revised – if necessary – annually by the CIFP and the EFPM authorized representatives.
